MARKETPLACE 'TRAINING FOR CARERS'

There are about 135,000 working carers in Wales of which some 4,500 are in Pembrokeshire. Work is important for well-being, income and to keep social contacts. Some carers have given up work due to their caring role, other carers might like to get back into employment. Carers have a whole variety of skills, experience and expertise but training tailored to carer's needs will help to sustain the caring role and/or becoming more employable.

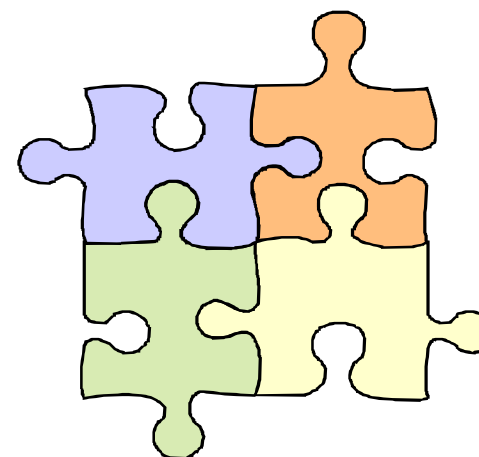
