Ynni Adnewyddadwy ar Raddfa Cymunedol Renewable Energy at Community Scale

The Welsh Assembly Government's Ynni'r Fro Programme uses European Structural Funds to provide support and funding to encourage the development of community scale renewable energy schemes across Wales.

Technical development officers

A network of locally-based technical development officers is in place across Wales to help groups develop their projects and access funding streams.

Preparatory stage grants

Up to £30,000 is available to fund feasibility studies and other preparatory costs.

Capital grants

A grant of up to £300,000 is available towards the capital costs of a renewable energy project.

Who can apply?

- Social enterprises that meet the Welsh Assembly Government's definition of a social enterprise, please see energysavingtrust.org.uk/ynnirfro

- Projects must be based in Wales and generate energy from a renewable source
- Projects should be able to employ at least 1 part time employee within the first 2 years of completion
- Hydro schemes should expect to generate at least 240,000kWh per annum, wind schemes should expect to generate at least 800,000kWh per annum
