New Booklet from Jobcentre Plus

Jobcentre Plus has just produced a new booklet about volunteering whilst on benefits (reference code JSAL 7JP). This focuses on the *advantages* of volunteering whilst on benefits; for example, it emphasises that employers look favourably on volunteering as it shows that potential employees have something to offer and can show commitment, and that making a positive contribution can really boost a person's self-confidence.

The booklet contains useful information on how to find voluntary opportunities, and has contact details for various volunteering organisations. It also tells you what you need to take into account regarding benefits, such as informing your local Jobcentre Plus office when you begin volunteering. Volunteering should NOT affect your benefits as long as you do not receive payments other than for expenses incurred.

U Can!

The *U Can!* Project aims to empower and support Disabled People to become involved in social, leisure, educational and work related activities inclusive of voluntary opportunities within their local community. Disabled People are either sign-posted to an appropriate organisation or linked with one of our trained volunteers who provide support on a fortnightly basis to help clients become involved in such activities and as a consequence grow in confidence and meet new people. The project is about 'enabling' the client to have the confidence to make new contacts and friends through this support.

Efallai mai ychydig o sesynau yn unig gyda chynghorwyr fydd ar rai pobl eu hangen i'w cyfarwyddo i hyfforddiant lleol neu i waith trwy chwilio swyddi targedig.

Trac - Progress 2 Work

Are you over coming a substance misuse problem? Are you ready to move on to training and work? Trac have specialist advisers to help you!

Trac helps people of working age who have changed their drugs use sufficiently to enable them to enter training and employment for 16 or more hours per week and are unemployed or claiming benefits.

Trac has a good reputation for helping people back into work. They have strong links and partnerships with local employers, which creates direct opportunities for helping unemployed people, often with a variety of barriers back into work.

Progress 2 Work

It is a flexible service aimed at supporting people with previous drug problems back into training and work. Trac p2w will take referrals from any agency and develop programmes tailored to help people consider, plan and manage their entry into training or work.

Some people may simply need a few sessions with an advisor to signpost them into local training or through targeted job searching into work.

Others may have barriers to resolve and need longer periods of flexible and customised support to prepare them for work, which may include:

- Support on debt and homelessness
- Confidence building and motivation sessions
- Access to a pilot group 'work prep' initiatives
- Help with I.T, literacy and interviewing skills
- Referral to specialist training agencies

The programme is confidential and voluntary and will not affect your rights to benefits.

DESPERATELY SEEKING VOLUNTEERS!

Mencap Stackpole Gardens is an organisation which aims to provide an environment and facilities where those with learning difficulties can develop social skills and practical skills, leading to personal development.

The organisation now urgently needs volunteers to work with students with learning disabilities who are studying for a qualification in gardening; the role requires volunteers to assist students with portfolio development for their coursework and with planning and maintaining garden plots. Expenses will be paid and transport may be available on the student bus.

St John's Hall, Pembroke Dock needs play assistants at its Parent and Toddler group, which is held every Friday morning between 10 and 12. The assistants will support the Parent and Toddler group by facilitating play; encouraging play activities such as group games; storytelling; speaking to parents; helping with refreshments, etc. Ongoing training and support will be provided.

Pembrokeshire Advocacy needs volunteers to sit on its management committee. In particular they need to recruit a Treasurer, but they would like to fill other committee roles as well. Volunteers should be interested in issues surrounding learning disability. Pembrokeshire Advocacy is an independent volunteer organisation with a principal aim of representing the individual interests of people with learning disabilities living in Pembrokeshire. The organisation avoids any conflicts of interest by remaining independent of statutory authorities. Its responsibilities remain solely with individuals that it supports. The organisation endeavours to:

- Protect people from physical, emotional or financial abuse.
- Support individuals to make decisions at major transactional points in their lives.
- Ensure people's legal rights and entitlements are observed.
- Ensure people receive a high quality service and that individual's wishes are respected and acted upon.

Nod mudiad Gerdidi Ystegbwll Mencap yw darparu amgylchedd a chyflusterau lle gall y rhai sydd ag anawsterau ddatblygiad yr sgiliau cymdeithasol ac ymarferol, gan arwain at ddatblygiad yr unigolyn. We are currently recruiting Delivery Partners (DPs) for the scheme, i.e. groups who would like to run a volunteering programme for young volunteers aged 16-24. Any organisation which recruits volunteers in the 16-24 age group is welcome to apply to the Wales Council for Voluntary Action (WCVA) for DP status, and funding of up to £7000 may be available to help with volunteer expenses etc. We can help groups by giving advice and training on setting up a programme, by helping to recruit volunteers, and by assisting with applications for funding.

Becoming a Millennium Volunteer

Any young person aged 16-24 who is interested in volunteering for any of our registered organisations can become a Millennium Volunteer (MV). We have over 250 organisations on our database with well over 400 volunteering opportunities available, so there is plenty of choice! Alternatively, groups of young people can start up their own volunteering projects - please contact Volunteering Pembrokeshire if you would like further information on this.

You will get certificates of achievement when you have completed 100 and 200 hours of volunteering, and the scheme is now well-recognised by schools, colleges and employers; so being a MV can be an asset to your school Progress File, can help your UCAS application to get noticed and can enhance your CV! All out of pocket expenses will be covered by the scheme.

Help Make a Difference

All over Pembrokeshire, voluntary organisations are at work to make the county a better place. At the heart of every one of them, from the largest charity to the smallest community group, there is a board of Trustees. Could you be one of these volunteers helping to make a difference your community?

Who is a trustee and what is a trustee board?

- A trustee is a member of a group of people—the board of trustees, management committee or governing body who have ultimate responsibility in a voluntary group
- Trustees must act in the best interests of the voluntary group
- Trustees are usually volunteers but they can be paid in exceptional circumstances. Out of pocket expenses are usually paid for the work they do

What are the responsibilities of a trustee?

- Make big decisions about the future
- Ensure everything is legal and safe
- Ensure the work of the charity is carried out

What are the benefits of being a trustee?

- You are at the centre of the action, helping to decide things which matter
- You can help support your community - ensure the services the voluntary group provides meet the needs of the people they are serving
- You can put your skills and experience to good use, to benefit your community or to provide better services for people who need them
- You can learn new skills and gain confidence in a whole range of areas - from finance to management to team working and decision-making

- Anyone over 18 years old

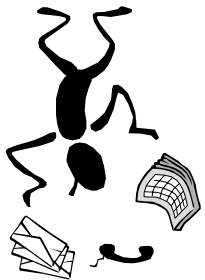

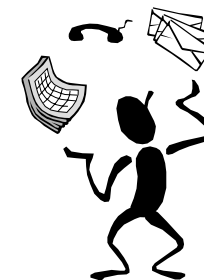

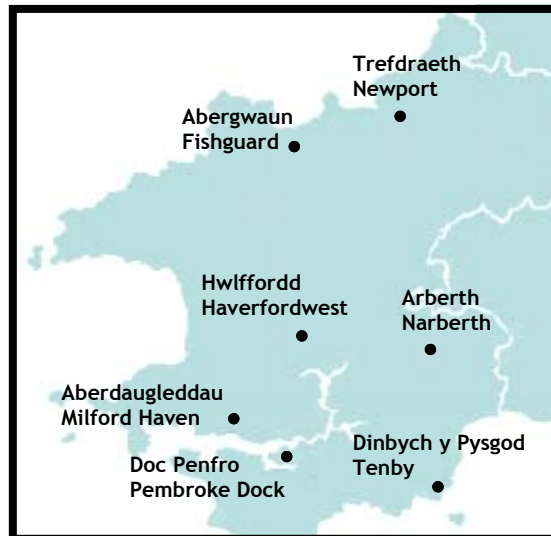
