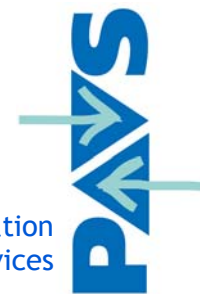

The 200 hours certificate is signed by First Minister Rhodri Morgan of the Welsh Assembly Government.

### **Ymarferoldeb Leonard Cheshire**

Mae rhaglen Ymarferoldeb Leonard Cheshire yn gwaredu'r rhwystrau sydd ynghlwm â hyfforddiant cyfrifiaduron i bobl sydd ag anableddau. Mewn partneriaeth â chwmnïau, mudiadau yn y sector gwirfoddol a'r sector cyhoeddus, rhoddir hyfforddiant i gleientiaid trwy ddysgu o bell. Mae'r rhaglen yn agored i bobl anabl rhwng 19 a 60 oed sydd yn ddi-waith ac sydd wrthi'n chwilio am waith ar hyn o bryd. Darperir hyfforddiant ac offer am ddim i ymgeiswyr llwyddiannus - ni bydd costau heblaw am gostau dosbarthu a galwadau ffôn i'r rhyngwyd. Cynigir gwasanaethau gan wirfoddolwr cyfrifiadurol i gynnig cefnogaeth yn y broses pe bai angen. Darperir hyfforddiant drwy colegau sy'n cynnig cymhwyster mewn technoleg gwybodaeth sylfaenol. Dyrennir tiwtor personol i bob cleient gan y coleg. Mewn ambell achos gellir cynnig cwrs sydd wedi'i bersonoli pan fo cysylltiadau mewn lle gyda phartner hyfforddi lleol. Mae dros draean o raddedigion Ymarferoldeb wedi llwyddo i gael canlyniad cadarnhaol. Amrywia ystod y deilliannau o waith cyflogedig, hunan-gyflogaeth a phrofiad gwaith i addysg uwch a gwaith gwirfoddol.

Organisations wishing to encourage younger volunteers can apply for a Millennium Volunteers grant of between £50 and £7000. Grant monies can be used to recruit more volunteers to build on your organisation's existing activities, or to start new initiatives. The deadline for applications for the current round of funding is **9<sup>th</sup> December 2005**.

PAVS Volunteering Pembrokeshire is the Local Coordinating Partner (LCP) for the scheme in Pembrokeshire and we are inviting groups to contact us for help and advice with recruitment, starting new volunteering initiatives and accessing Millennium Volunteers grant money. ### **Leonard Cheshire Workability**

Leonard Cheshire's Workability programme lifts the barriers to computer training for people with disabilities. In partnership with companies, voluntary and public sector organisations, clients are given training via distance learning. The programme is open to disabled people, aged between 19 and 60 who are unemployed and actively seeking employment. Training and equipment are provided free to successful applicants - only delivery costs and telephone calls to the internet need to be paid for. Clients may have the services of a computer volunteer to provide support in the process. Training is provided through colleges offering a qualification in basic information technology. A personal tutor is allocated to each client by the college. In some cases a more personalised course may be offered where there are links to a local training partner. More than a third of Workability graduates have already achieved a positive outcome. Outcomes range from paid employment, self employment and work experience, to further and higher education and voluntary work.

# DESPERATELY SEEKING VOLUNTEERS!

It is *not* counselling, although the same care and attention may be offered; the basis of help is a "supportive relationship".

Pembrokeshire MIND works to encourage people experiencing emotional or mental health problems towards a more fulfilling life through developing mutually beneficial friendships and a network of support.

**Meals on Wheels**, a scheme run by the WRVS, also urgently needs volunteers throughout the county to deliver hot meals to their clients, especially in the following areas: Fishguard, Narberth, Haverfordwest and Milford Haven. Deliveries are at lunchtime for about one and a half hours daily, number of hours worked weekly can be negotiated.

**CARDS FOR GOOD CAUSES** - This group of 28 National charities came together in 1959 to co-ordinate publicity and selling of their Christmas cards.

**WHERE can you find them?** - There are over 300 temporary shops in churches, empty shops, tourist venues etc. all over the U.K.. The shop in Haverfordwest Library is in the exhibition area inside the Library.

**WHEN can we buy them?** - We plan to open from Monday 31 October to Friday 9 December, BUT

**HOW can you help?** - We do need volunteers, to be in the shop from 10am to 5pm every week day, and 10am to 1pm on Saturdays. Could you come for a day, or half a day, or just a few hours?

**Does ALL THE MONEY go to the charities?** - Last year we returned at least 81p in every pound, out of which the charities had to pay for the cards and any VAT. Over 7million was raised in total last year, so do come and join us and be part of this worthwhile venture.

## Return to Earn - the new stepping stone to employment

Return to Earn is a new scheme which is aimed at helping people get into permanent employment. It involves a fully paid placement, either part-time or full-time, with a local employer.

### *Can I apply to join 'Return to Earn'?*

You can apply to join the scheme as long as you are over 18, you live in Pembrokeshire and you are currently not in employment.

### *What careers are on offer to me?*

Return to Earn offers a number of placements to choose from:

Care - such as working with older people either in residential homes or through providing care in the own homes

Childcare - such as working in a nursery or a crèche

Building Trade - such as brick-laying, carpentry, plumbing, painting and decorating, electrician

Construction - such as plant machinery

Landscaping and gardening

Hospitality - such as working in hotels and restaurants

### *What will I get out of it?*

You will be offered a meaningful placement with the opportunity of learning a trade. As part of your placement, a training programme may help you to gain relevant qualifications to support your chosen career.

### *Earn while you learn*

The scheme offers you paid employment helping you to get into your chosen career while at the same time achieving the necessary qualifications. It is these added benefits that we think will help you to gain permanent employment at the end of the placement in the career of your choice.

### *How long does the Return to Earn scheme last for?*

The placement lasts for 20 weeks - around five months. Placements are available either full-time or part-time.

Lletygarwch - megis gweithio mewn gwestai a bwytai

### *Beth sydd ynddo i mi?*

Cynigir lleoliad gwaith ystyrlon i chi gyda'r cyfle i ddysgu crefft. Fel rhan o'ch lleoliad, bydd rhaglen hyfforddi efallai'n fodd i'ch cynorthwyo i ennill cymwysterau perthnasol a fydd yn cefnogi'ch gyrfa dewisedig.

You will be paid the minimum wage. You may be able to get working tax credits.

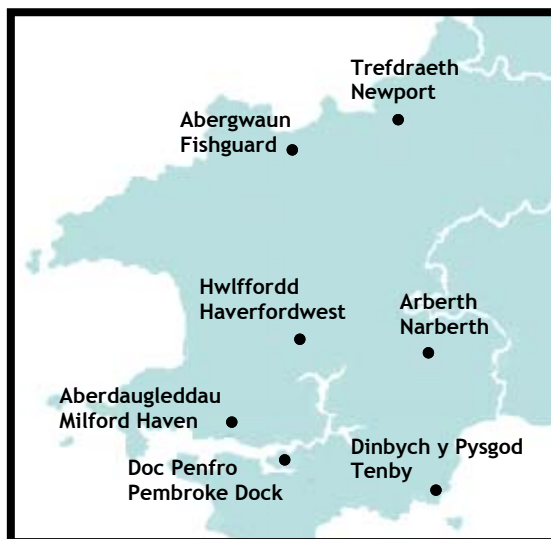
